Johannes Hevelius was one of the greatest astronomers of the 17th century. He was a man of many talents – the Gdansk Leonardo da Vinci. He is known as the astronomer who created the map of the moon and named many stars and constellations. Also, as the constructor of astronomic utensils and gifted graphic, who illustrated his works by himself. He was also a businessman – brewer and as social activist became a councillor for City Council and as assessor.

Year 2001 is officially declared by the Polish Parliament as Hevelius Year. Mr Bronisław Komorowski, the President of

Poland, serves honorary patronage.

1. The competition is of open character – every creator of graphic signs is welcome to participate.
2. The goal of the competition is to commemorate 400th birth anniversary of great Gdańsk astronomer Johannes Hevelius.
3. The organisers are:
 - Gdańsk Community Foundation
 - Treasure Island, Gdańsk Archipelago of Culture
4. Each author may submit unlimited number of individually created works, connected with the theme of the competition. At least one of the submitted works must be done exclusively for the competition (i.e. not presented elsewhere).
5. The submitted works will be judged separately in the following categories:
 - ex libris and small graphic form – traditional techniques
 - ex libris and small graphic form – digital techniques
6. The works shall not extend the size of 130 x 130 mm.
7. The works shall be submitted in three copies, all of them signed and marked at the back side with the data: name and surname of the author, technique and year of creation, opus number and size (height x width). The works shall not be glued or framed.
8. The works shall be accompanied by filled and signed entry form. The works missing a fully filled entry form will not be considered.
9. The submitted works will not be returned and become ownership of the organisers, are at their disposal including the right to free distribution in any way.
10. The works shall be sent by mail to the Gdańsk Community Foundation, ul. Dickmana 2.1/ 80-339 Gdańsk, street "Ex Libris 2011".

12. The deadline for work submission is April 30, 2011 (post stamp in decisive).
13. The works will be judged and prizes shared by the jury consisting of acknowledged graphic artists and representatives of the organisers. The jury reserves the right to divide prizes differently to what is stated in point 14. The jury's decisions are final.
